The Silicon Valley Symphony is proud to feature violin prodigy Stephen Waarts playing the Sibelius "Violin Concerto" conducted by Michael Paul Gibson. Stephen will be playing an unnamed Strad made circa 1732 – 1734 when the master was about 90 years old! But in fact some of Stradivari's greatest creations date from that time period. Our Strad is a twin of the Lord Wilmotte Strad, previously belonging to Yehudi Menuhin, and made at the same time, same wood, same varnish, same model, same workmanship, and same condition.

There are two performances of our "Waarts Plays Sibelius" Concert – first in Menlo Park at Holy Trinity Episcopal Church on Saturday, May 19, 2012, at 7:30 PM. AND in Palo Alto at Saint Mark's Episcopal Church, on Sunday afternoon, May 20, 2012, at 5:00 PM. The orchestra offers a stinging performance, tantalizing and fun - *The Wasps: Aristophonic Suite* by Vaughan Williams (no insect will be harmed during the performance of this piece :-), and the fabulous *Romeo and Juliet - Fantasy Overture* by P.I. This is the fifth performance with Stephen Waarts. Stephen is now 15 years old, a scholarship student at the Curtis Institute of Music in Philadelphia studying with the renowned Aaron Rosand. Stephen has played four major violin concertos with the SVS: Tchaikovsky (age 12); Brahms (age 13); Mendelssohn (age 14); and Saint-Saëns (age 15).
